# SASNR Combined Keelboat Provincial Championships

Will be sailed from,

Lake Deneys Yacht Club, Vaal Dam 9th of August to the 12th of August 2018.

## NOTICE OF RACE

The Regatta is organized by SAS NR in conjunction with Lake Deneys Club under the auspices of South African Sailing (SAS).

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 2020.
- 1.2 The South African Sailing Requirements for Regional Class Championships will apply. (SEM02)
- 1.3 Boats participating in this regatta shall conform to the **Equipment Rules of Sailing** (ERS) 2017 2020, the Class Rules of the participating classes, this **Notice of Race**, and the **Sailing Instructions**.

## 2 ADVERTISING

Advertising is permitted subject to the limitations of World Sailing Regulation 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all classes of Keelboats who have 5 or more entries by Monday the 6<sup>th</sup> of August 2018.
- In accordance with the World Sailing Regulation 19 (Eligibility Code), all competitors (Helmspersons and all other crew) shall be members in good standing of a Yacht Club affiliated to and in good standing with South African Sailing or their Member National Authority in the case of non-South Africans. The Yacht Club name and membership details shall be stated on the entry form or crew list. Current valid South African Sailing Membership Cards or similar proof of MNA Membership in cases of non-South Africans shall be presented at Registration.
- 3.3 Owners, helmspersons shall be members in good standing of the class associations of the participating class.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form on line at www.windsail.co.za and sending it, together with the required fee, to:

By close of business (16h30) on **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> August 2018**.

- 3.5 Confirmation of payment as outlined in 3.3 above shall clearly show the entrants name, sail number, and be e-mailed together with the Entry Form, to the Regatta Secretary.... please ensure all payments are made by due date to validate your on-line entry.
- 3.6 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:
  - 1. In person and in cash during registration (10h30 11h30) at LDYC 9<sup>th</sup> August 2018 ... at the increased fee (an additional R150.00 per boat).

#### 4 FEES

**4.3** Other Fees:

All Entry Fees and Class subscriptions shall be paid prior to the close of Registration. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the affected yacht being recorded as Did Not Compete until such time as the required payment/s is/are made. This changes rule A11 (DNC)

#### 5 SCHEDULE

**5.1** Registration:

Thurs 9th Aug From 10h30-11h30

Measurement and safety inspection: at the discretion of the classes

Thurs 9<sup>th</sup> Aug From 10h30 -11h30

**5.3** Skippers Briefing;

A voluntary skippers briefing will be held in the LDYC club-house at approximately **11h30 on Thursday 9th Aug**.

**5.3** Dates of racing:

Thurs. 9<sup>th</sup> Aug Warning signal for the first race of the regatta at 13h00

Fri. 10<sup>th</sup> Aug Warning signal for the first race of the day at 10h00 Sat. 11<sup>th</sup> Aug Warning signal for the first race of the day at 10h00 Sun. 12<sup>th</sup> Aug Warning signal for the first race of the day at 10h00

**5.4** Number of races:

A maximum of **12** races are scheduled.

No warning signal will be made after **13h00** on the last day of racing, Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

#### **6 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

#### 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the Regatta Secretary on completion of registration formalities.

## 8 VENUE

Racing will take place on the Vaal Dam adjacent to and/or in the vicinity of LDYC.

#### 9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as per the diagram in addendum 1 of the Sailing Instructions. It will show the order in which the marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.

## 10 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 will apply. (Two turn penalty)

#### 11 SCORING

- 11.1 Low Point System of Appendix A4 will apply.
- **11.2** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 (a) When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (b) When 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.
  - (c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races, excluding her two worst scores.

## 12 REGIONAL CLASS CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND CLASS CHAMPIONSHIPS

In order to qualify as a Regional Class Championship the following criteria shall be satisfied:

- ✓ A minimum of five valid entries have been received no later than the closing time for entries (refer clause 3 above)
- ✓ At least five finishers in any two races of the series.
- ✓ At least four races completed.

#### 13 SAFETY

- 13.1 Yachts shall comply with their class buoyancy and safety requirements.
- Youth category competitors shall wear a personal buoyancy aid at all times while afloat in a yacht. (Youth Category means competitors under 19 years of age at 31st December 2018)
- 13.3 Wet or dry suits do not constitute adequate buoyancy.

#### 14 SUPPORT BOATS

Coach or individual support boats and spectator craft, shall be marked with a **White Flag** and shall remain no less than 150m from areas where boats are racing, between the Preparatory Signal and the last competitor finishing the race. Failure to comply shall result in action from the Protest Committee.

#### 15 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

## 16 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

#### 17 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

#### 18 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

**SASNR Medals** will be awarded in accordance with the Requirements for Regional class Championships, as follows:

5 – 7 boats Gold

7 – 10 boats Gold & Silver

10 or more boats Gold, Silver and Bronze

Class Prizes will be awarded.

### 19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organising Authority nor its officials or other persons associated with the organisation of the event will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 20 INSURANCE

Each participating boat is encouraged to carry sufficient valid third-party liability insurance to cover any liability arising during the event.
